數十個伊朗城市的街道上充滿憤怒和蔑視，抗議活動以多年未見的規模進行。據伊朗人權組織稱，至少有 50 人被殺，有跡象表明即將進行嚴厲鎮壓。抗議活動是由一名 22 歲的女子在臭名昭著的道德警察的拘留中死亡所引發的，他們說她因不遵守嚴格的伊斯蘭穿著規定而拘留了她。
