因此,人類傾向於將自然區分開來。我們想把它分成我們可以理解的細胞和單位,但大自然並不是這樣運作的。自然作為一個整體系統運作,各種元素可以以我們甚至還不了解的方式相互影響。野化的核心原則之一實際上是減少對生態系統的管理。這是為了——讓自然回歸自然。把自然還給它自己。我們需要退後一步,意識到我們是自然的一部分,而不是與自然分離。我認為,如果人類能夠專注於自己的影響範圍,並在他們自己的小後院有所作為……我們的後院恰好是 27,000 公頃的大卡魯景觀,而且——對我們來說,能夠真正做到這一點是多麼榮幸把我們的時間花在改善這片土地上,讓它為人類和地球服務。

Located in South Africa's Great Karoo Region, the Samara Private Game 8) Reserve was established by Isabelle Tompkins's parents Sarah and Mark Tompkins, in 1997.
