TikTok 在向 CNN 的聲明中發誓,將捍衛蒙大拿州使用者的權利,稱州長簽署的法案侵犯了州內人民的第一修正案權利。TikTok 稱這一禁令是非法的,並表示希望向蒙大拿州人保證他們可以繼續使用該平台表達自己。
